

Thank you for your interest in the SCCC Honors College. Below is a checklist of everything to be submitted in order to apply to the program.

How to apply to the Honors College

1. Complete the Honors application (on reverse).
2. Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or other person familiar with your academic potential.
3. High school transcript and transcripts from any previous college. (unofficial copies accepted – **NOT needed from current students**). Include the following:
 - SAT and ACT Scores (**Currently test optional**).
(If submitting, download scores as a pdf from collegeboard.org or actstudent.org).
 - AP Scores for all AP tests taken (unofficial copies accepted for application purposes, download from collegeboard.org).
 - Grades for college coursework taken in high school or other colleges (unofficial accepted).
4. Include an essay of approximately 500 words that gives a perspective on you as both a student and individual. The topic is open but the essay should be reflective of your best writing ability.

You are welcome to submit a list of your extra curricular activities.

Scholarships

The Honors Program awards a number of scholarships annually. All students who are accepted into the Honors Program and have submitted a complete application (all components listed above) are automatically considered.
