ADMISSSIONS POLICY FOR STUDENTS WITHOUT A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED

Students who do not possess a high school diploma or the equivalent must pass the Reading Comprehension, Sentence Skills, and Arithmetic sections of the Computerized Placement Tests with passing scores as established by the Department of Education, to be admitted to a College program.
