How to Submit Application:

- 1) (Recommended Method) Go to <u>erie.gov/cor</u> and click on the button "Submit application online".
 - a. Fill out name, e-mail address, and phone number.
 - b. Upload notarized application.
 - c. Upload proof of address showing one year of NYS residence.
 - d. Upload proof of address showing 6 months of current Erie County address.
 - e. Click box to verify that you have attached the required proof of address.
 - f. Submit form the student will receive an automatic reply e-mail.
 - i. *** Each attachment must each be less than 2MB, and in either jpeg, png, or pdf format.
- 2) Send e-mail to cor@erie.gov
 - a. Put full name and phone number in e-mail subject.
 - b. Attach notarized application, proof of address showing one year of NYS residence, and proof of address showing 6 months of current Erie County address
 - c. Send e-mail the student will receive an automatic reply e-mail.

** If additional proof of address is required, a Comptroller's Office staff member will contact you.

The student will receive the certificate via the e-mail provided, which can be forwarded to the school.

Acceptable Proof of Address:

- NYS Issued Photo ID (Driver's License, Permit or Non-Driver's License) dated **over 1 year ago** with your current Erie County address. If you have this, no further proof is necessary.
- If you do not have a NYS Issued Photo ID dated **over 1 year ago** with your current Erie County address, you must provide:
 - One piece of Acceptable ID (see below) from over 1 year ago proving NYS residence
 - One piece of Acceptable ID (see below) from over 6 months ago proving current Erie County residence
 - **If you have moved to a different address in the prior 6 months, you must provide proof for each address that you have resided in during the 6 month period
- Acceptable ID is any of the following in the student's name:
 - NYS Issued Photo ID
 - Property Tax Bill
 - Utility Bill
 - Lease Agreement
 - Bank Statement
 - Parent(s) Federal or State Tax return showing student as a dependent
 - W-2 Statement
 - Pay Stub
 - Car Insurance Identification Card
 - High School Identification
 - High School Report Card/Transcript
 - Pistol Permit
 - Fishing License
 - Native American Address Verification

• Education Law, Section 6305, provides: "The chief fiscal officer of each county, as defined by Section 2.00 of the local finance law, shall upon application and submission to him a satisfactory evidence, issue to any person desiring to enroll in a community college as a non-resident student, a Certificate of Residence showing that said person is a resident of said county. Such person shall upon his registration for each college year, file with the college such a Certificate of Residence issued not earlier than two months prior thereto, and such Certificate of Residence shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance."

•• Education Law, Section 6301, Paragraph 4, defines: "Resident" A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year in the county, city, town, intermediate school district or school districts as the case may be for a period of at feast six months, both immediately preceding the date of such person's registration in a community college, or for the purpose of section sixty-three hundred and five of this chapter, his application for a Certificate of Residence.

In the event that a person qualified as above for state residence, but has been a resident of two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding his/her application for a Certificate of Residence pursuant to section sixty-three hundred and live of the chapter, the charges to the counties of residence shall be allocated among several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction thereof, of residence in each county.
