This report provides graphical information for selected items for your college and for a comparison sample of similar SUNY institutions. Not all surveys returned to ACT for processing are represented in this report. Student records with invalid responses ("Very Satisfied" through "Very Dissatisfied") to the random response check item (Section IIIA, Item 20) were eliminated from all data files and analyses. Also, to assure that no institution was overrepresented in the comparison statistics, ACT randomly selected, from each institution's valid survey records, the "target number" of returned surveys communicated to the campus survey coordinator by SUNY officials at the start of the project.

For all Likert scale items (e.g., a 5-point satisfaction scale), data are displayed for your institution's top and bottom items (based on item average) as well as the items with the greatest and least differences between your institutional results and those of comparable SUNY colleges. Please note that percentages may not add to 100 due to the effect of rounding.

The SUNY "Comparison Colleges" data used in this report are based on 2,288 student records from the postsecondary institutions listed below. Comparative data of this type are often referred to as "user norms" because they simply represent a composite of the data obtained by a number of institutions that administered the instrument during a particular period of time. Please note that your institution's data were removed from the comparison group data prior to comparisons.

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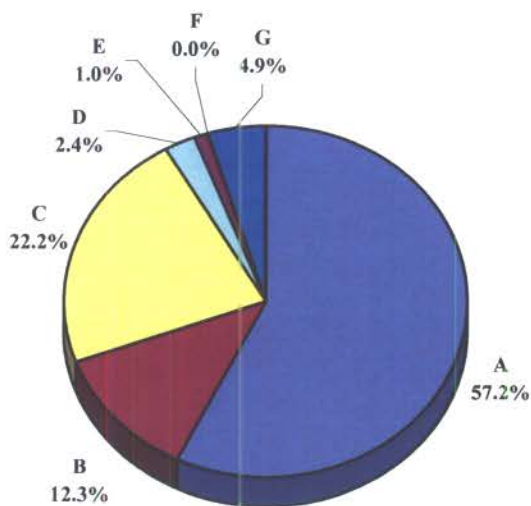

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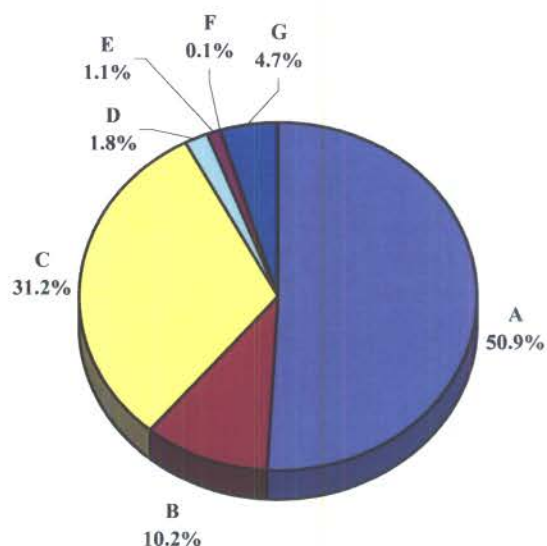

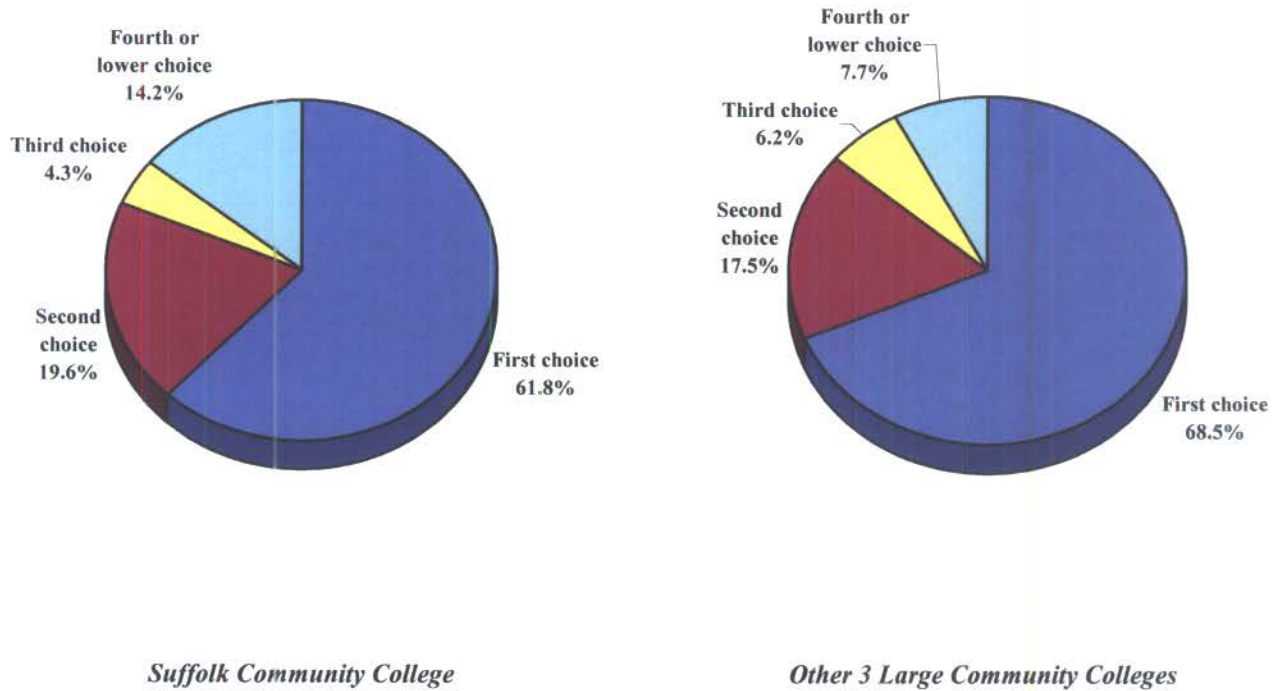


Figure 2. Section I, Item 2

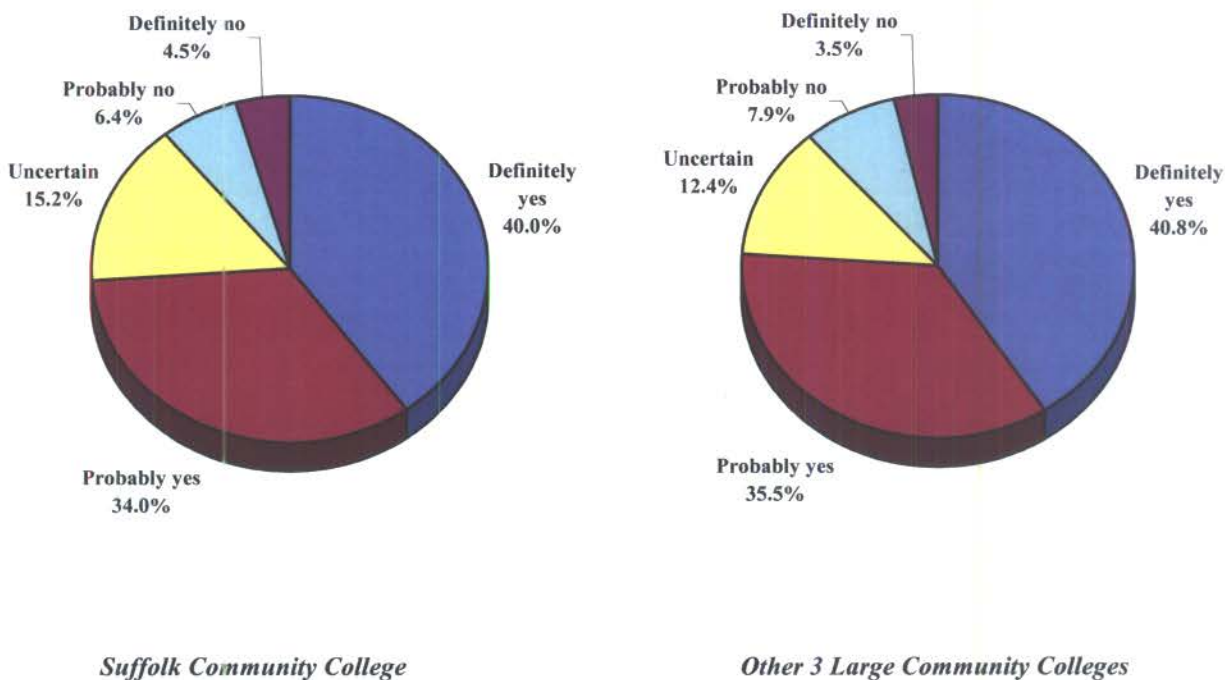
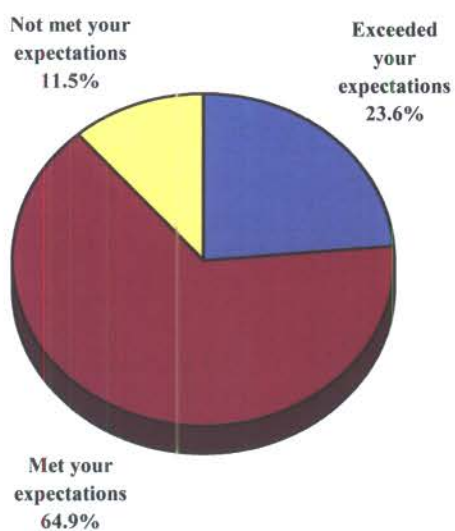


Figure 3. Section I, Item 3

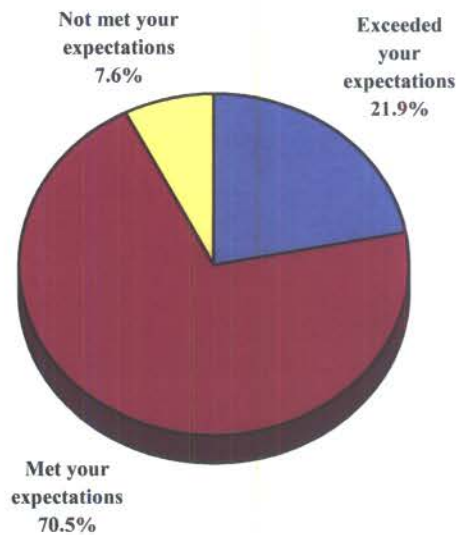

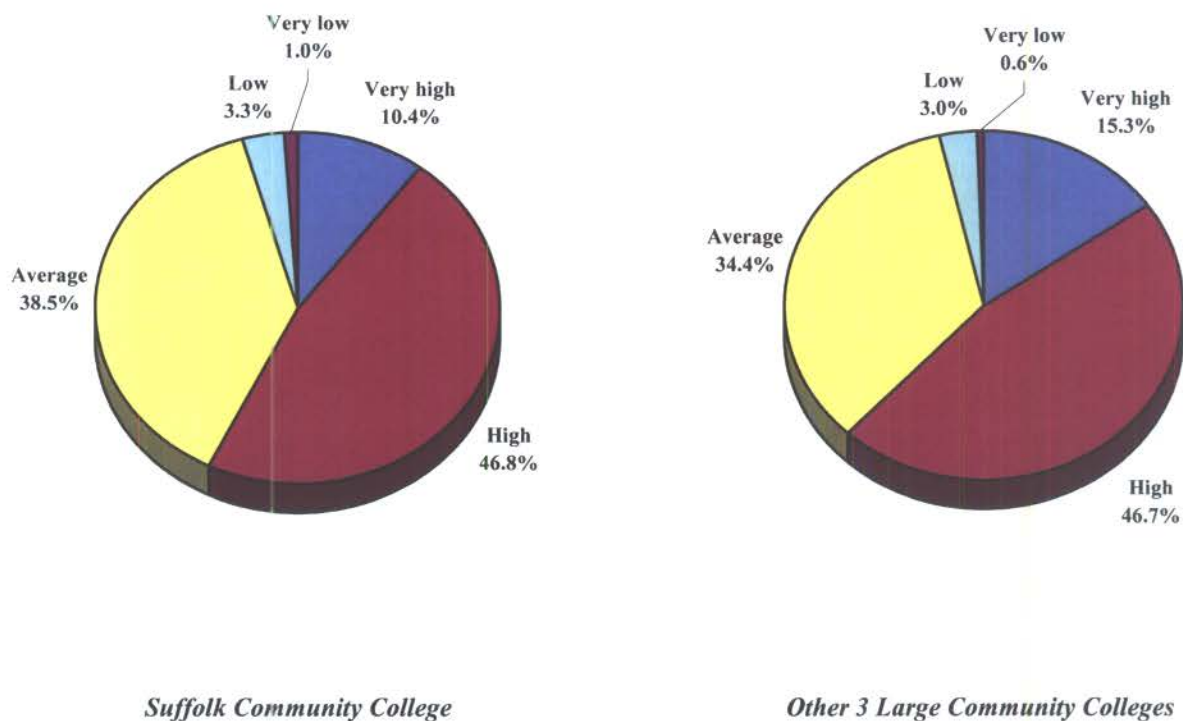
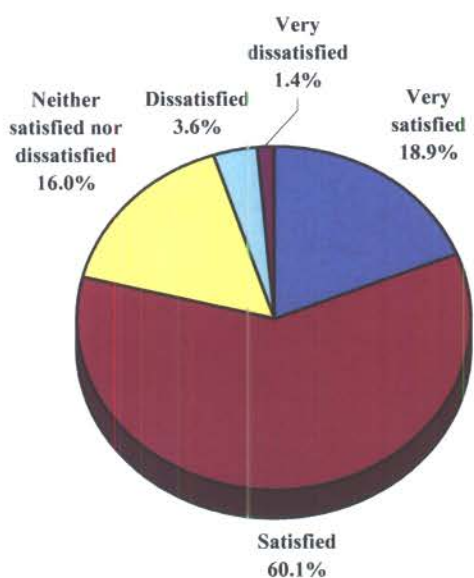


Figure 5. Section I, Item 5

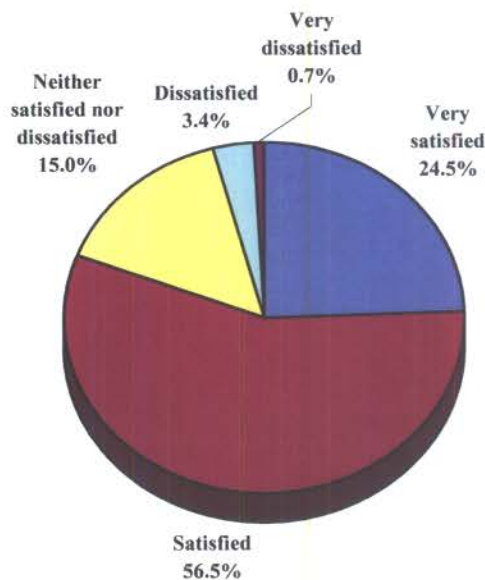

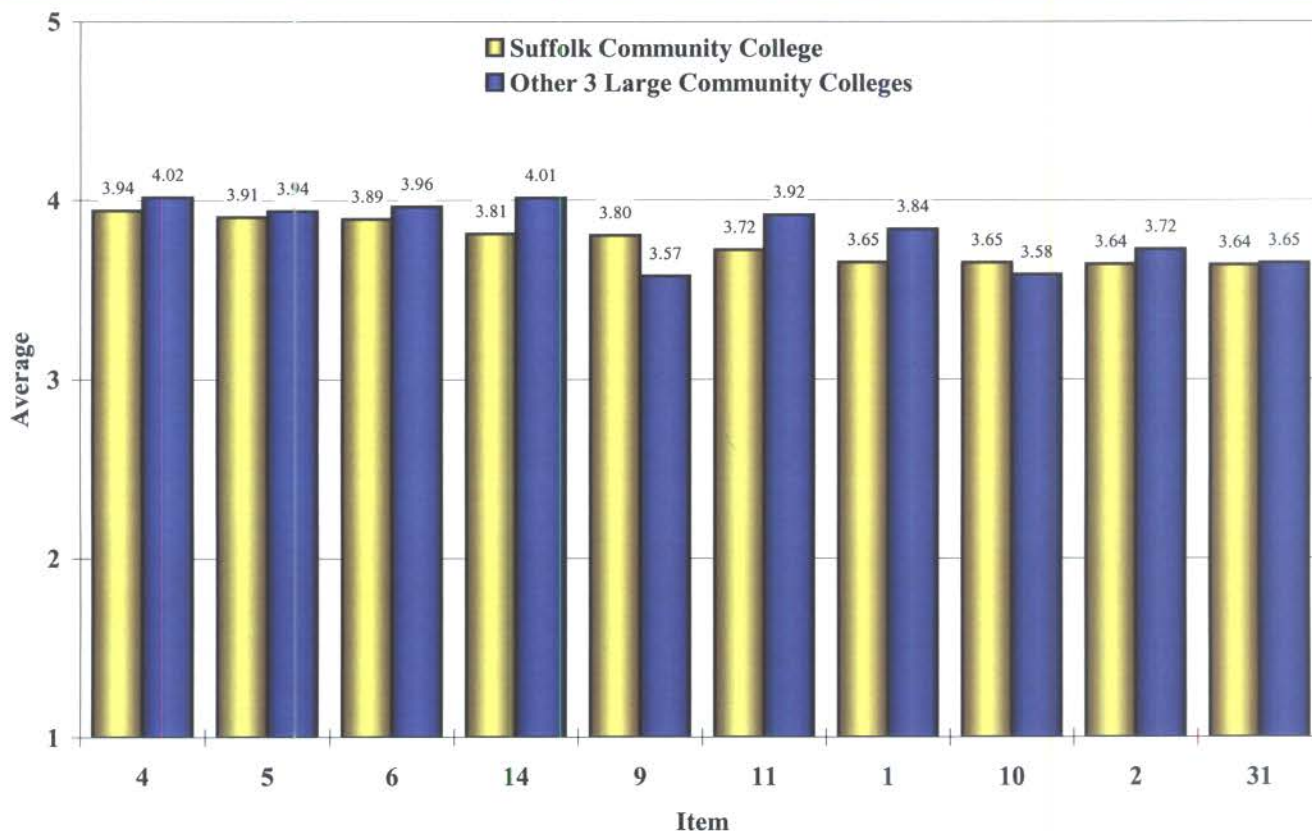


Figure 7. Section II, Items 1 through 31: Satisfaction With College Services and Facilities

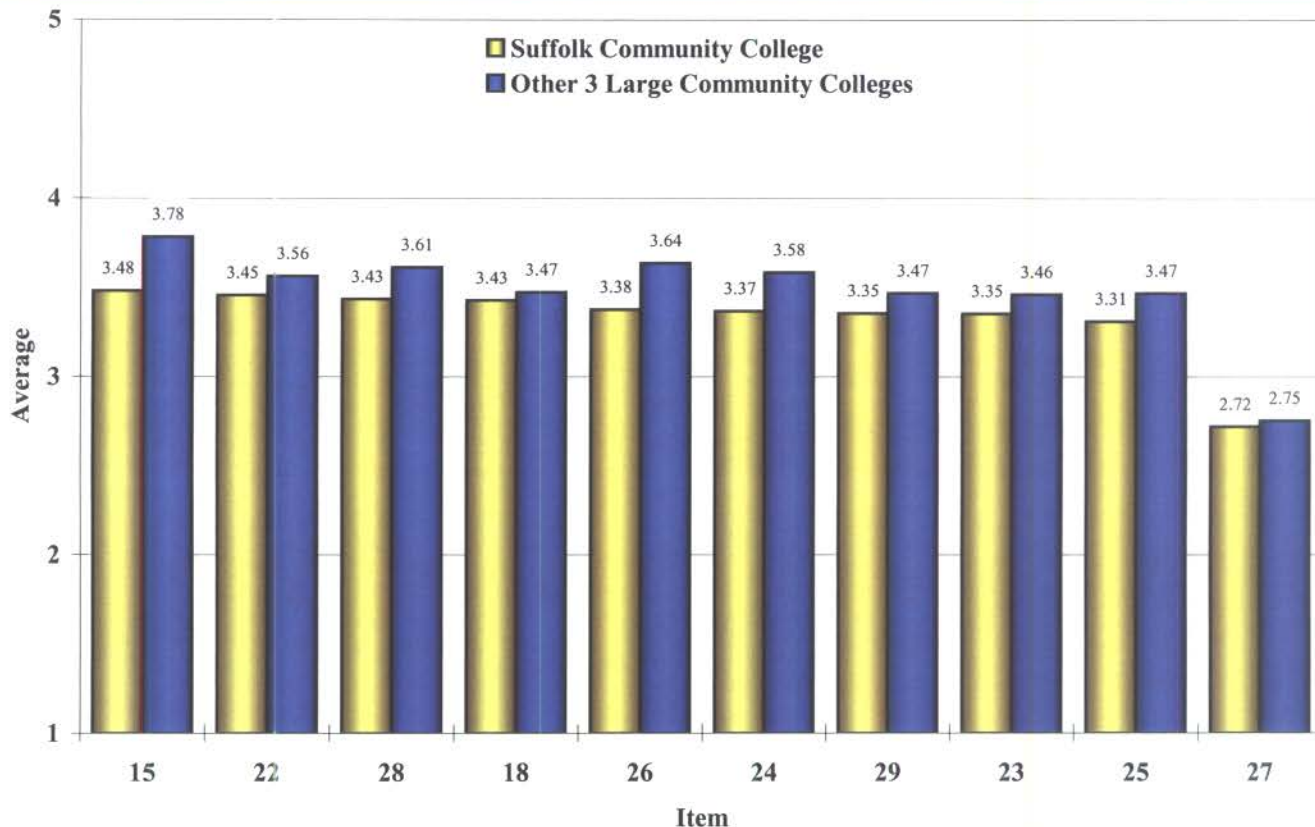


Figure 8. Section II, Items 1 through 31: Satisfaction With College Services and Facilities Bottom 10 Items (Based on Satisfaction Average) for Your Institution

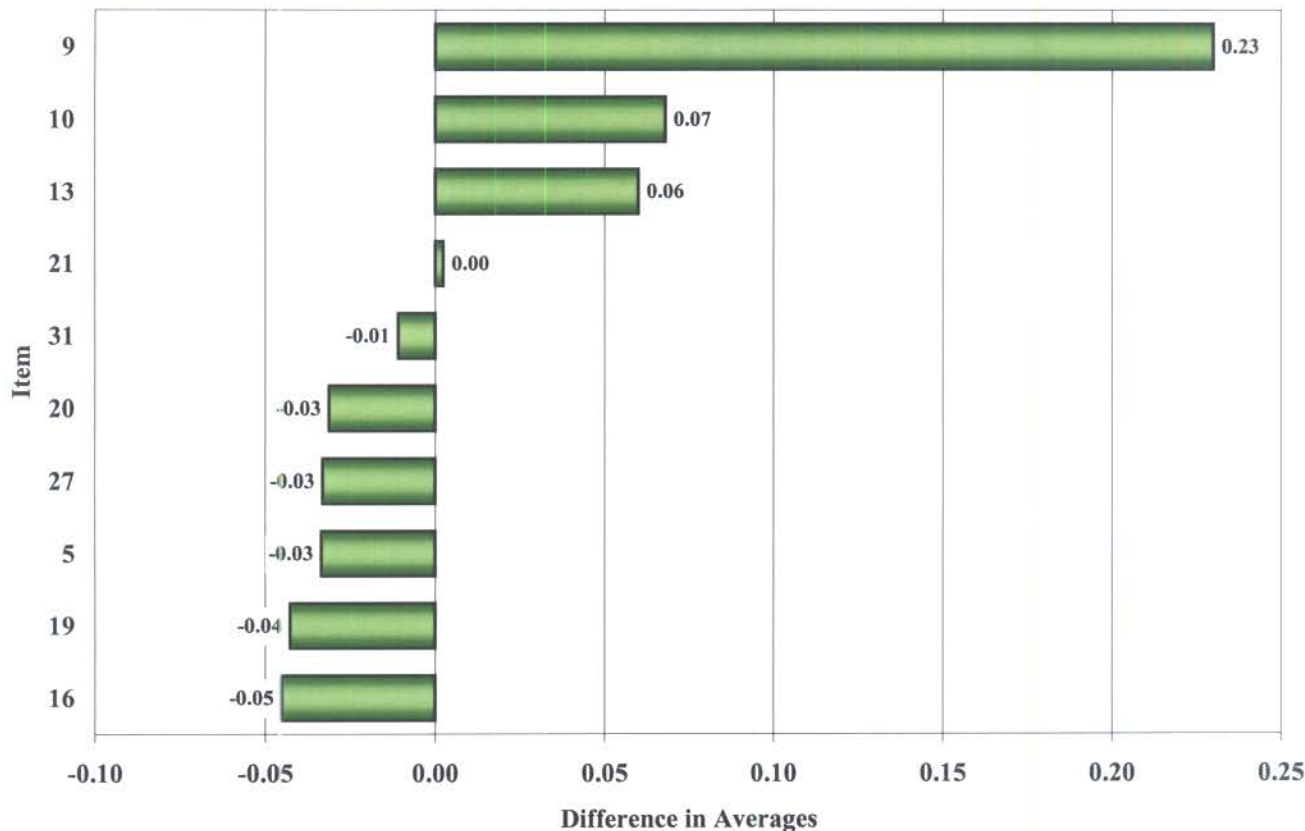


Figure 9. Section II, Items 1 through 31: Satisfaction With College Services and Facilities

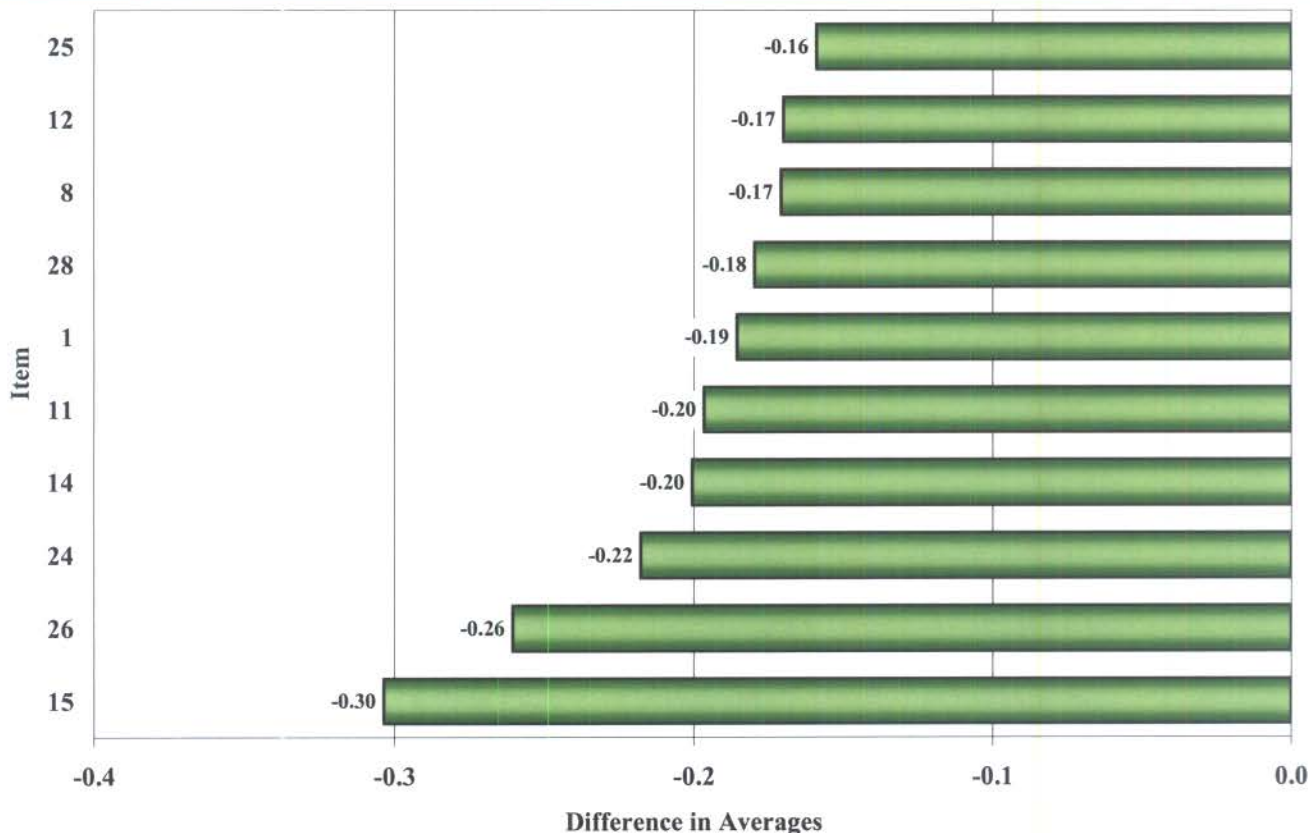


Figure 10. Section II, Items 1 through 31: Satisfaction With College Services and Facilities

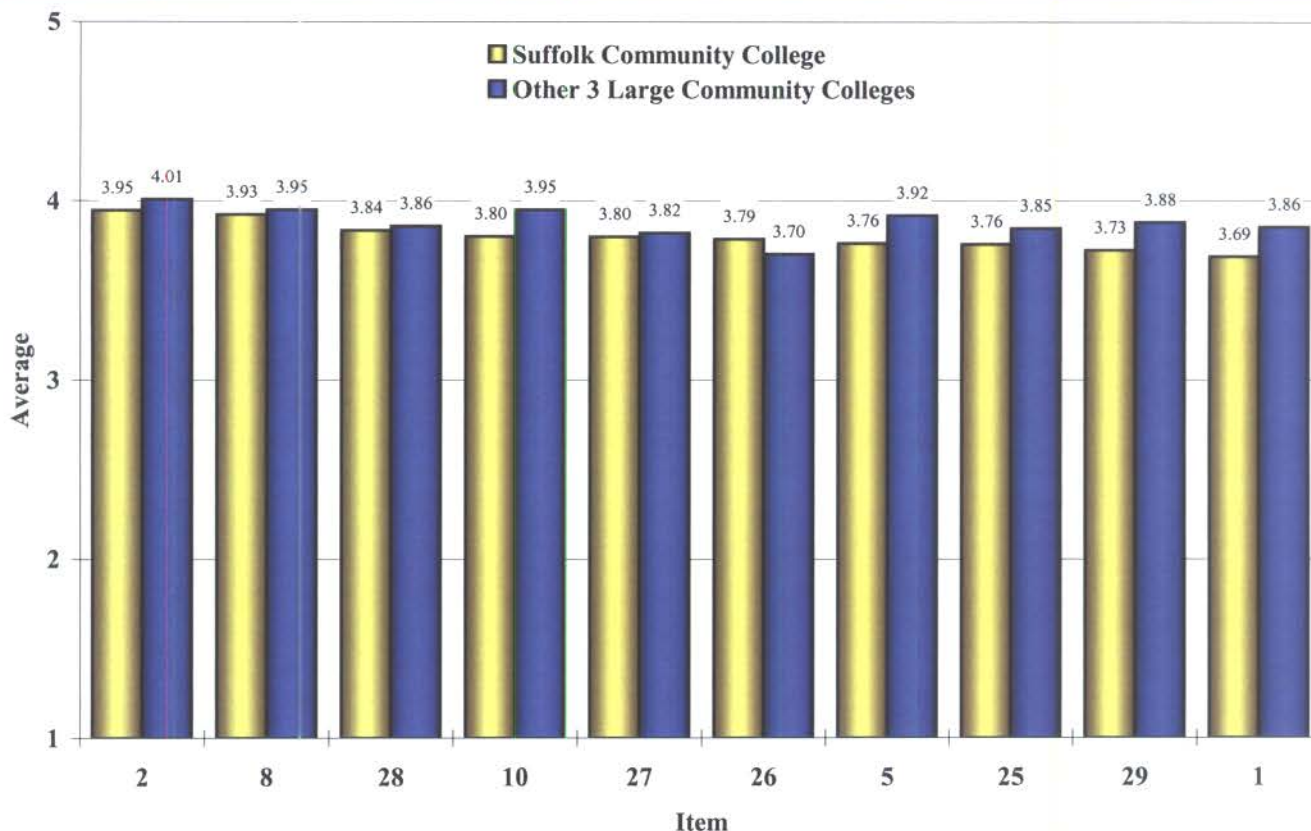


Figure 11. Section III A, Items 1 through 33: Satisfaction With College Environment/Climate

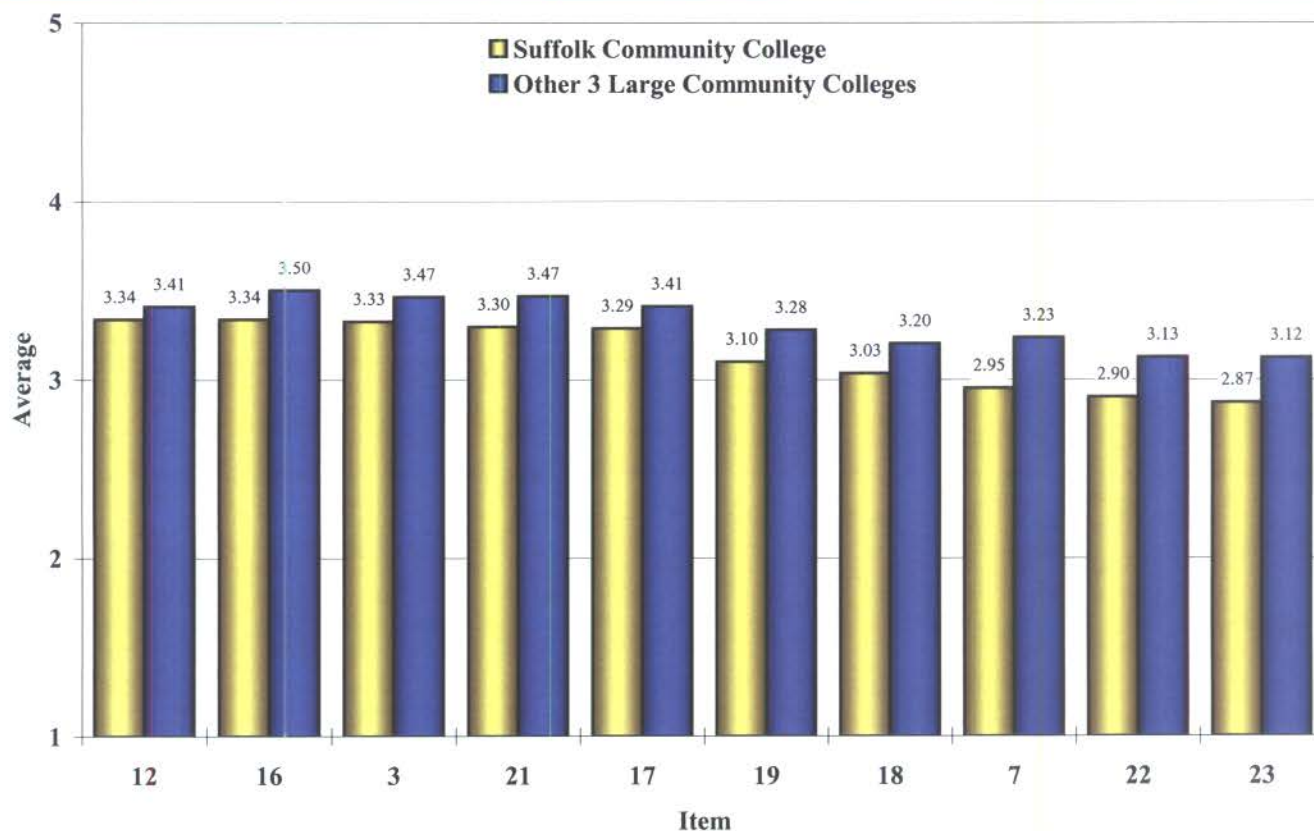


Figure 12. Section III A, Items 1 through 33: Satisfaction With College Environment/Climate

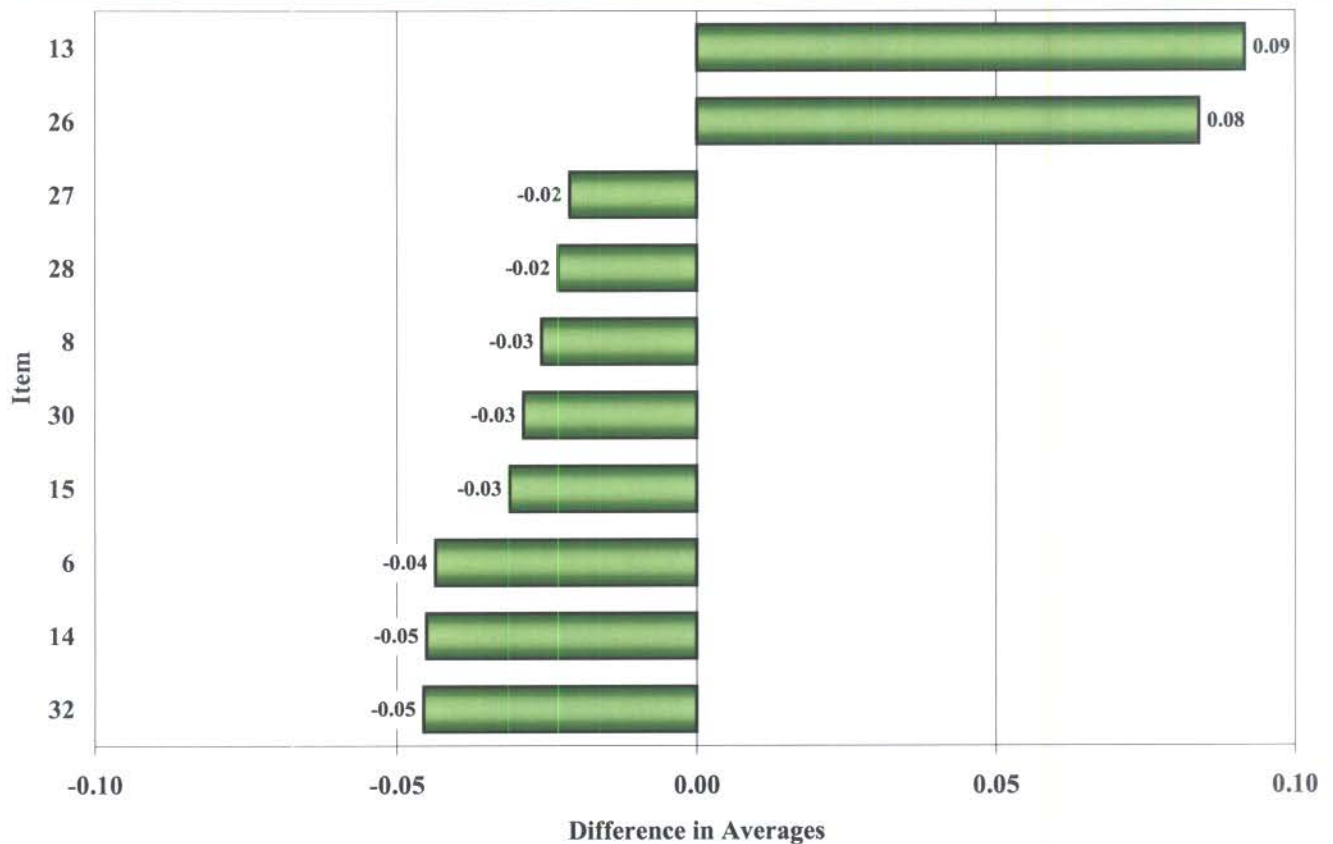


Figure 13. Section III A, Items 1 through 33: Satisfaction With College Environment/Climate

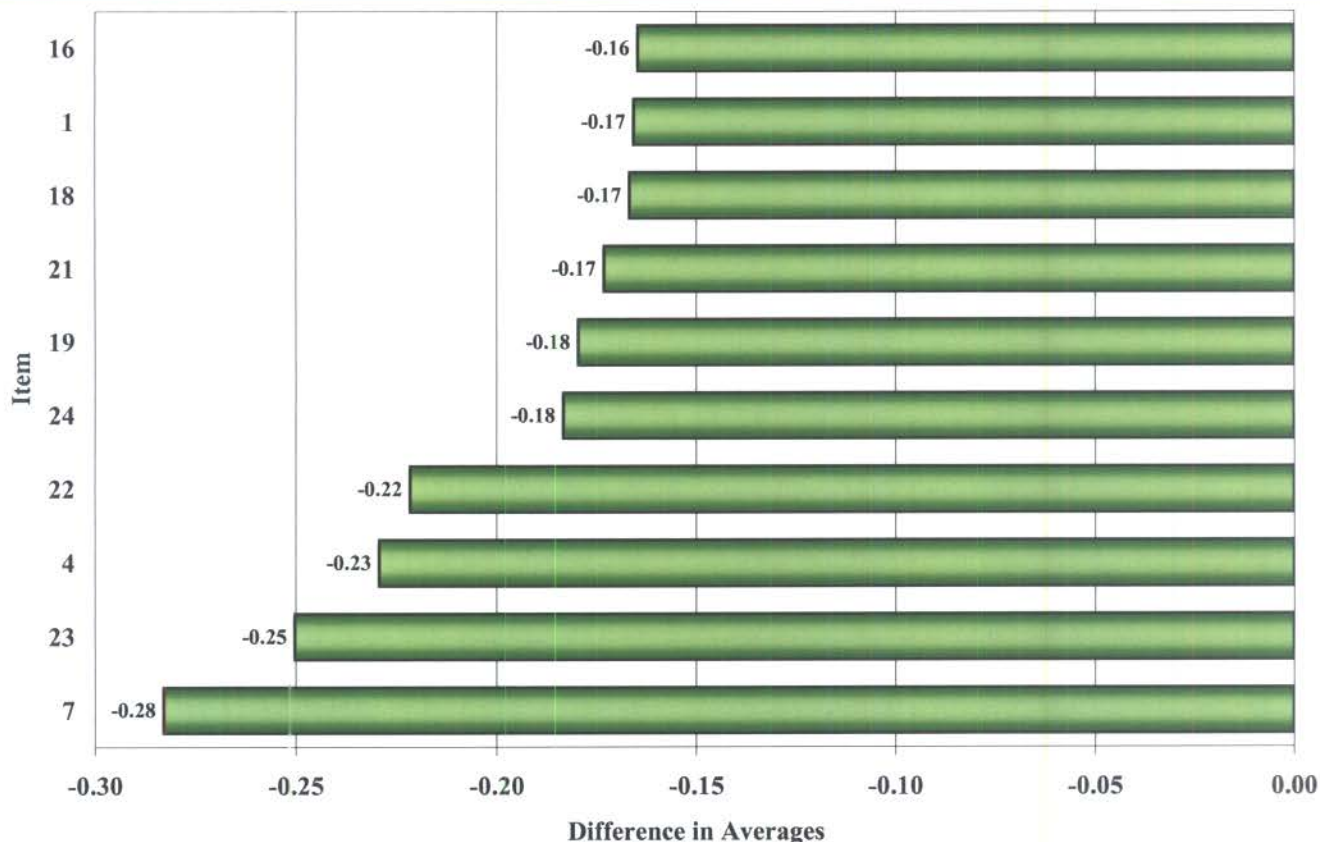


Figure 14. Section III A, Items 1 through 33: Satisfaction With College Environment/Climate

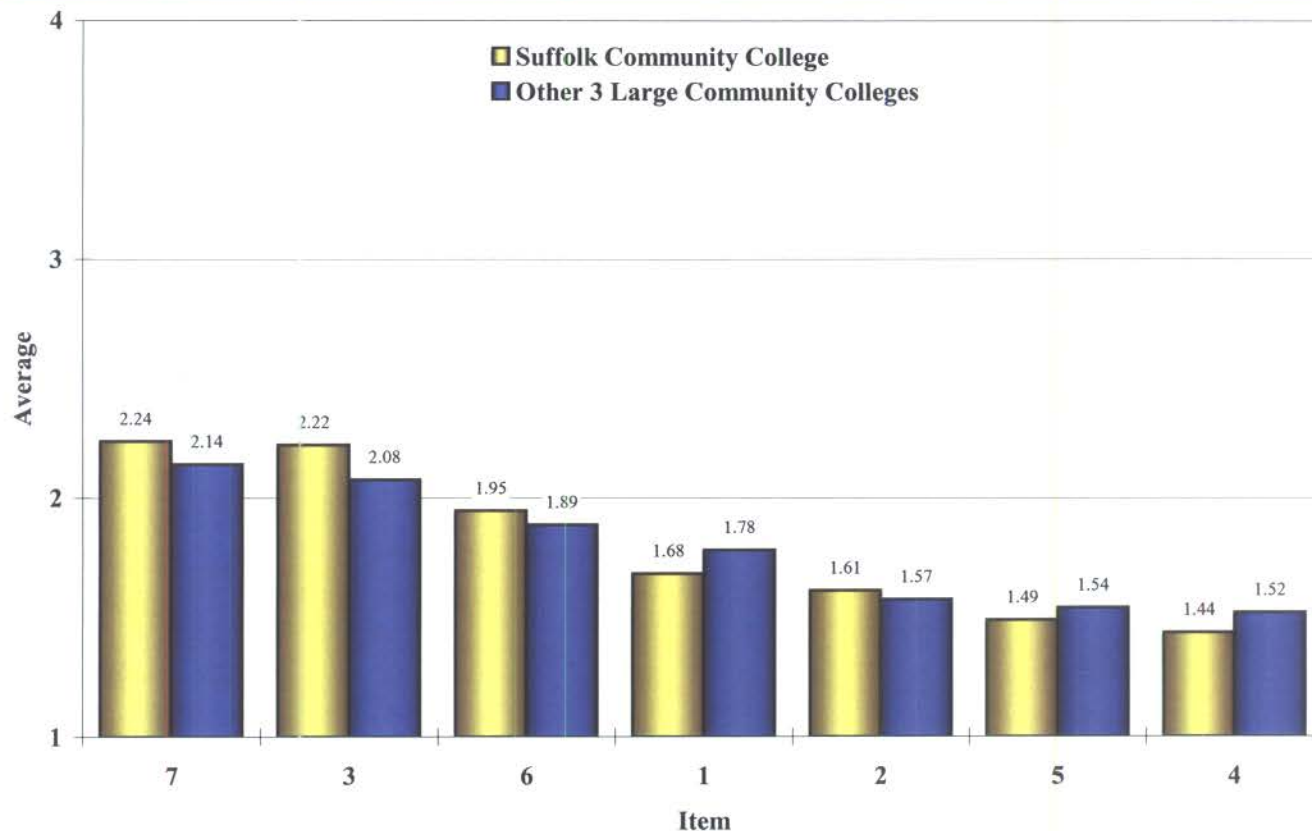


Figure 15. Section III B, Items 1 through 7: Problems When Taking Classes

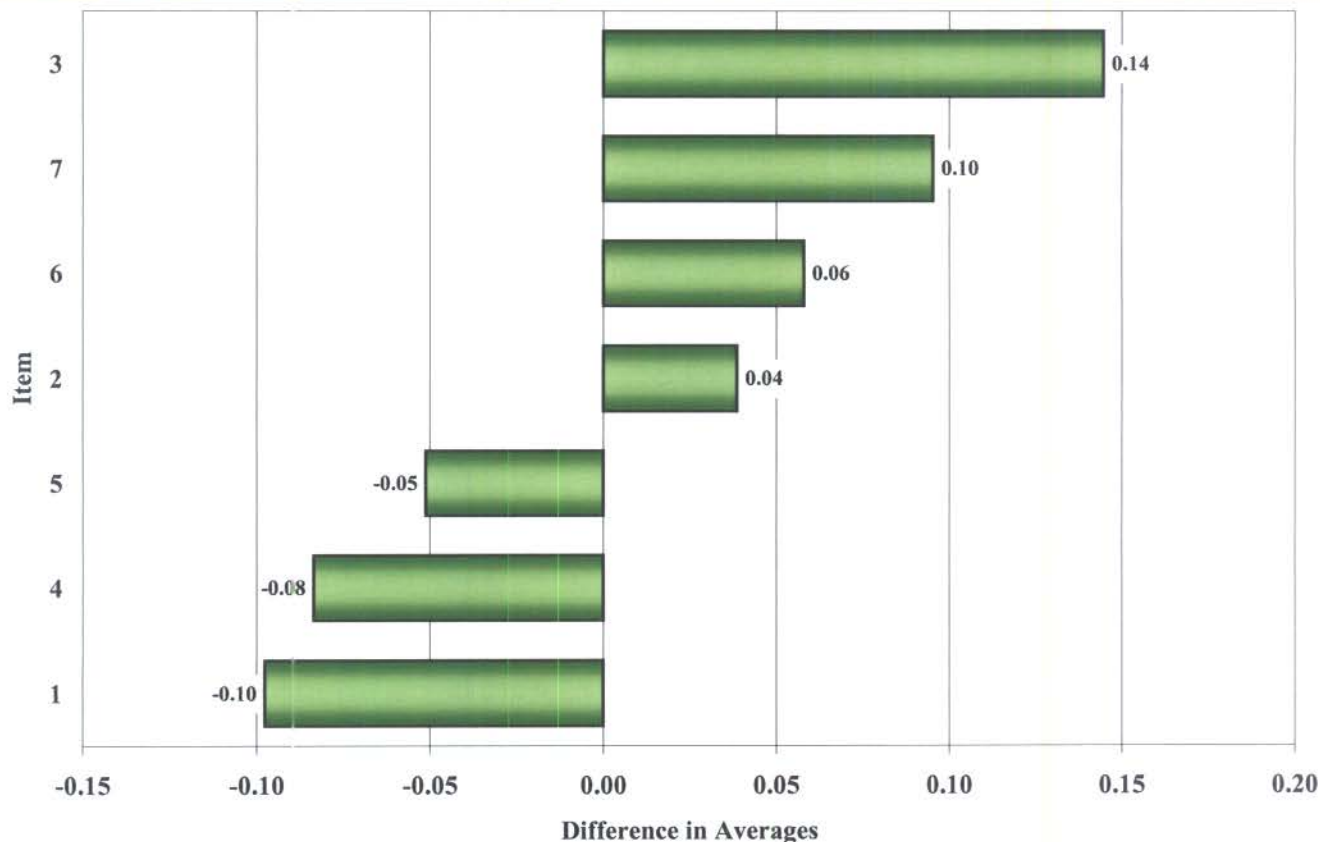


Figure 16. Section III B, Items 1 through 7: Problems When Taking Classes Ranked By Difference in Item Average Between Your Institution and the Comparison Sector

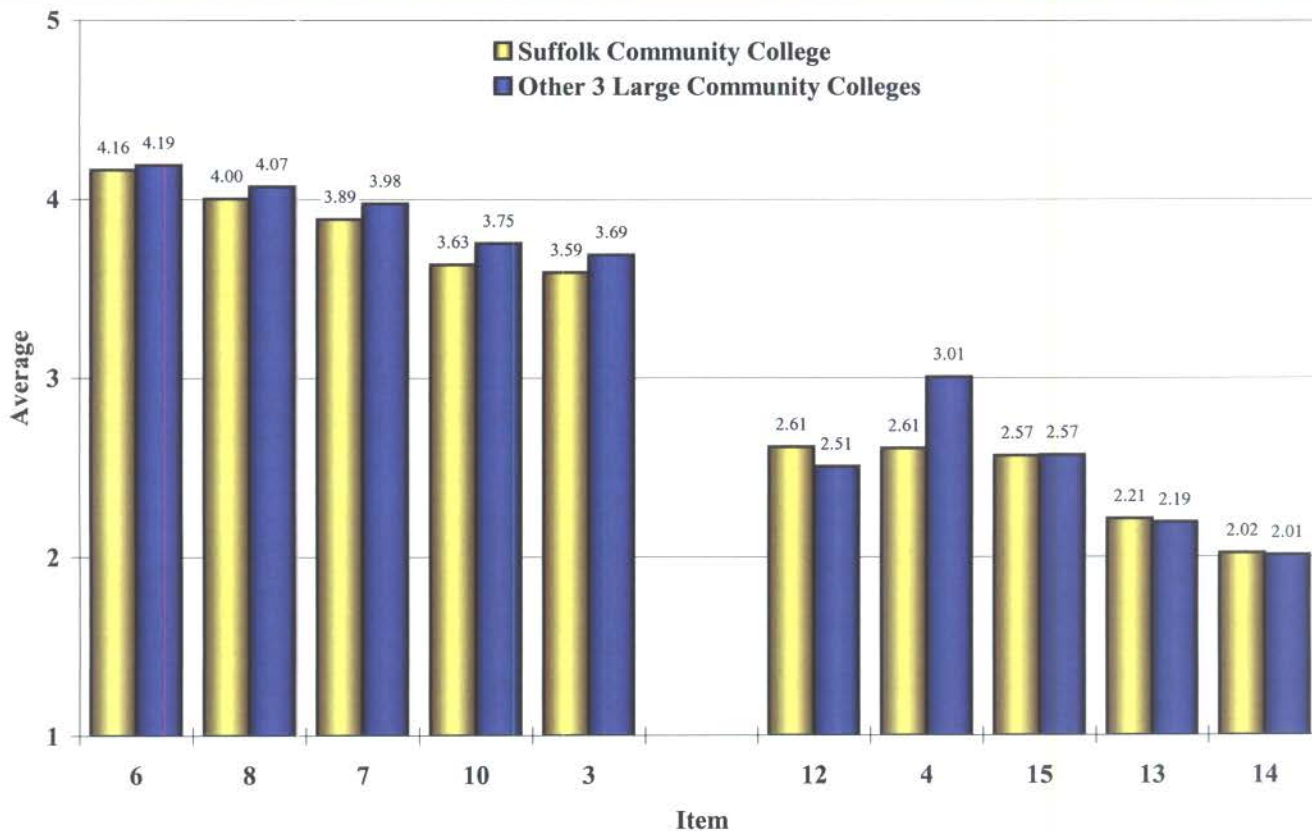


Figure 17. Section III C, Items 1 through 15: Academic Experiences at This College Top and Bottom 5 Items (Based on Item Average) for Your Institution

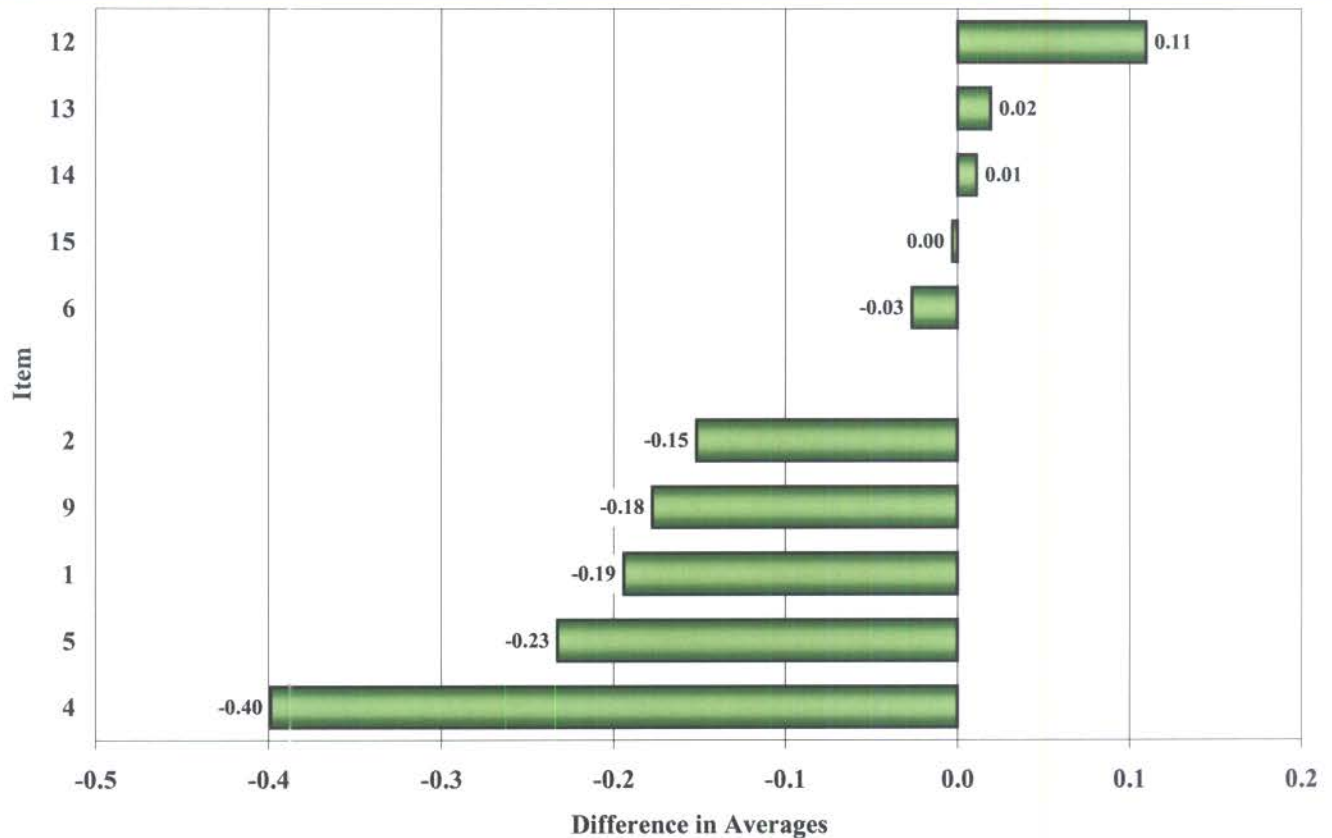


Figure 18. Section III C, Items 1 through 15: Academic Experiences at This College

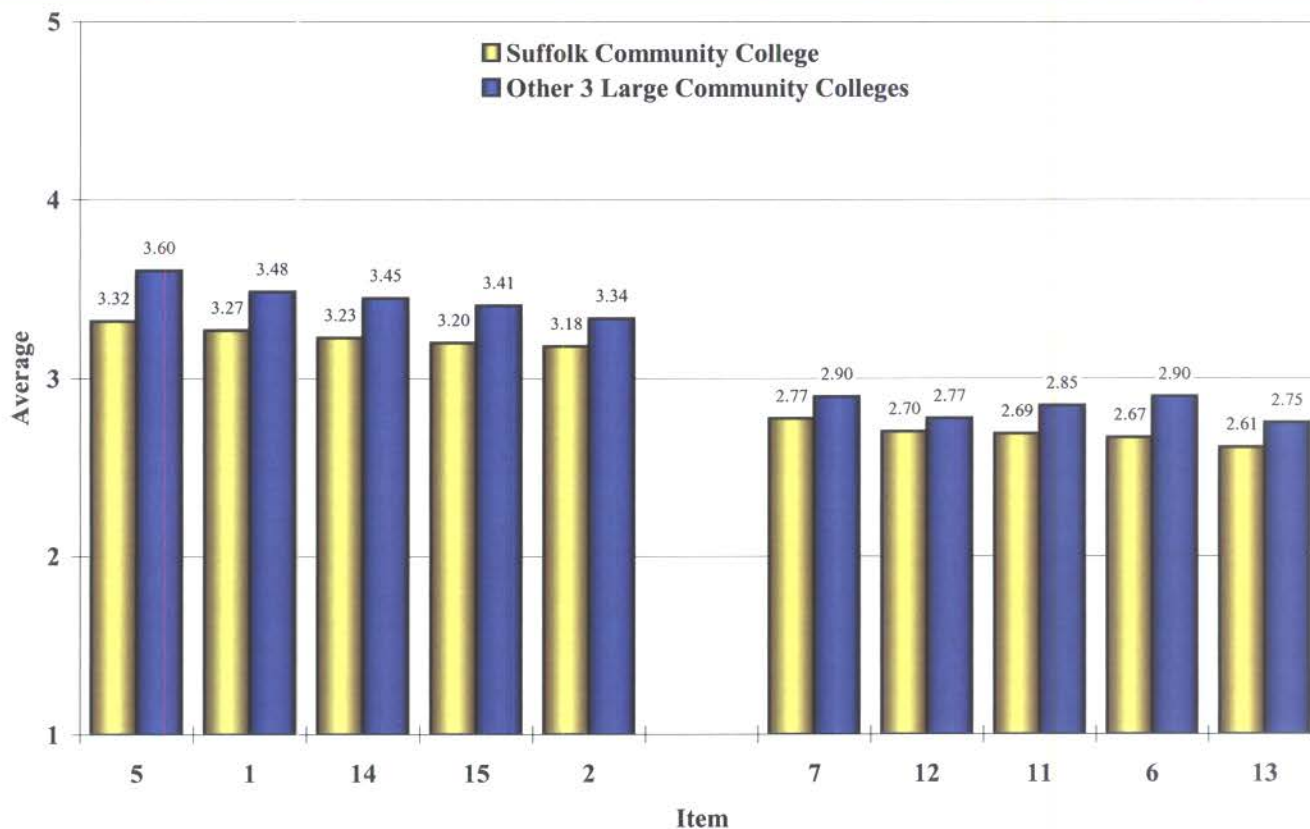


Figure 19. Section III D, Items 1 through 15: College Contribution To Individuals' Growth and Learning

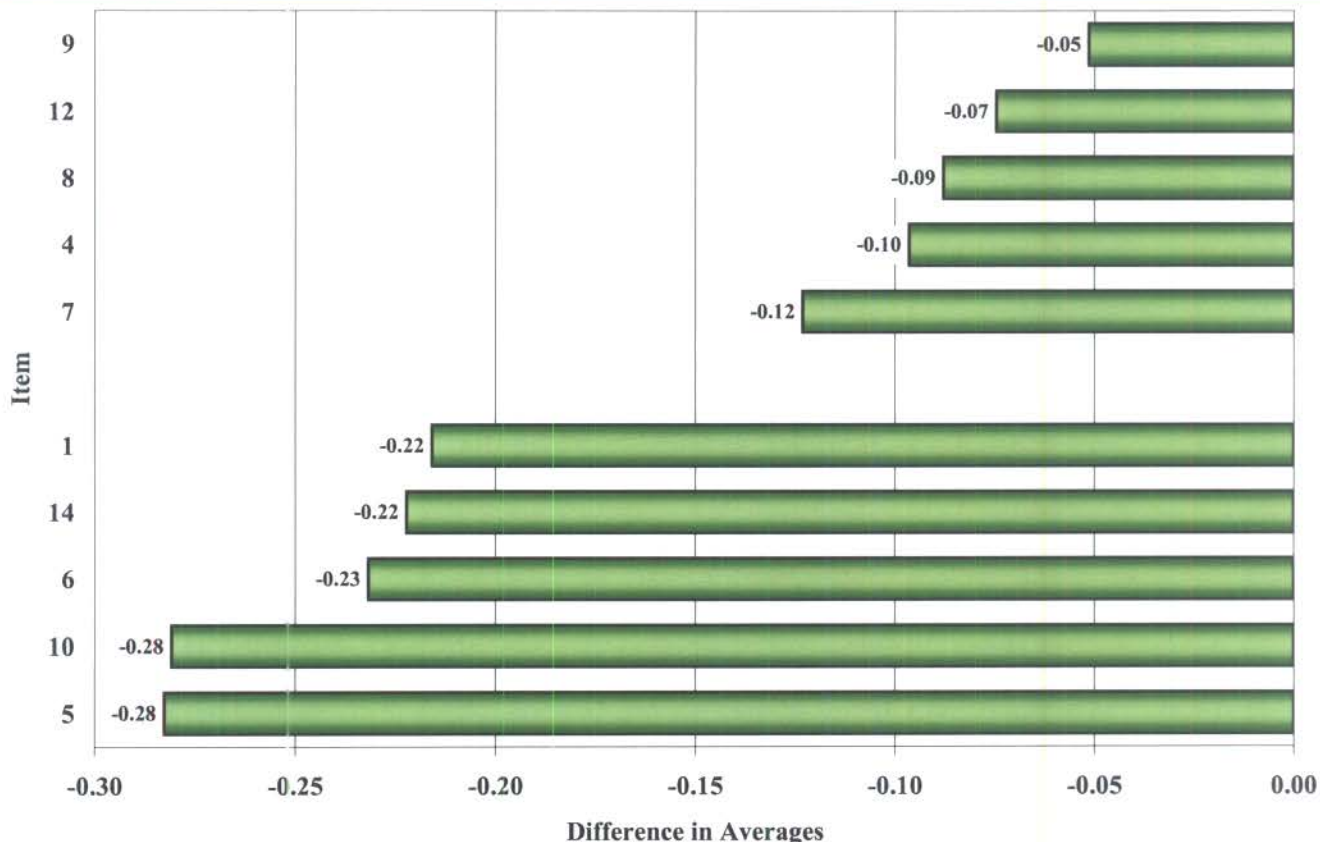
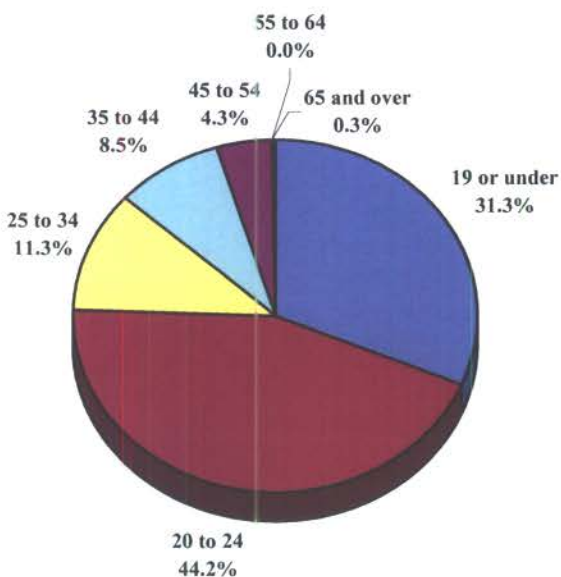


Figure 20. Section III D, Items 1 through 15: College Contribution To Individuals' Growth and Learning Top and Bottom 5 Differences in Item Average Between Your Institution and the Comparison Sector

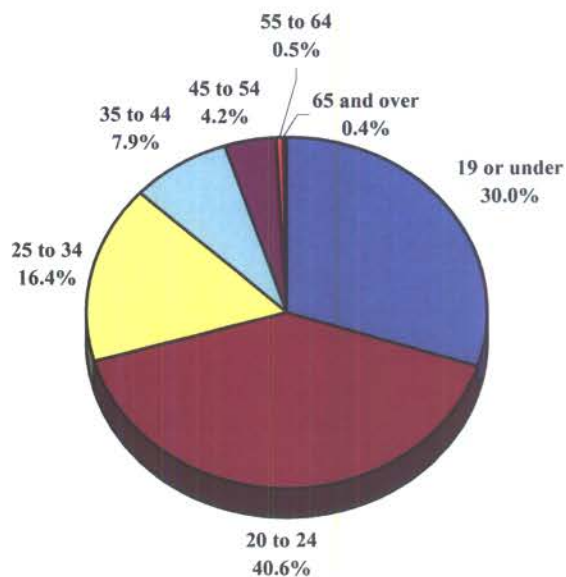

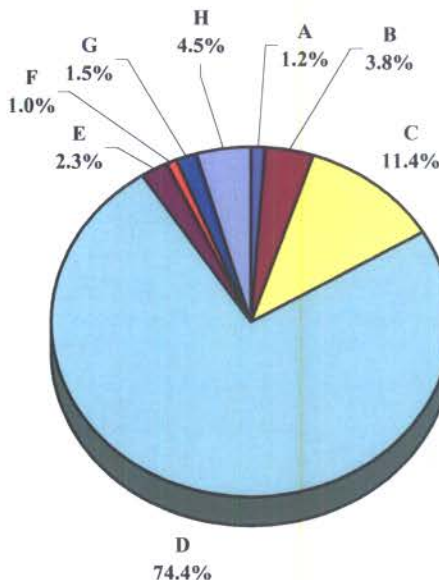
Figure 22. Section IV, Item 2

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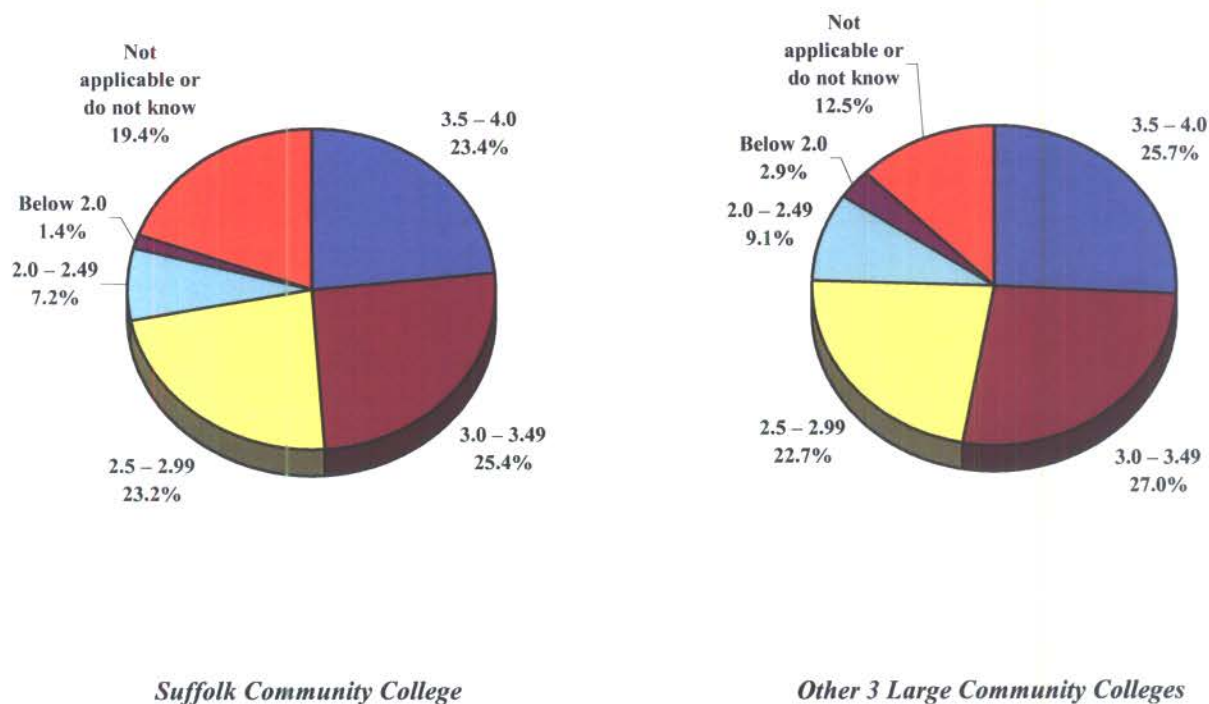
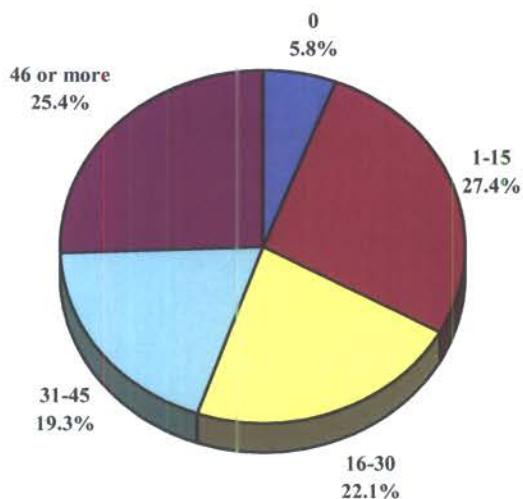


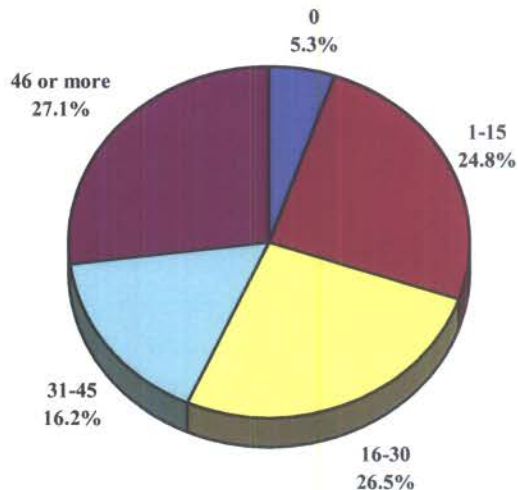
Figure 25. Section IV, Item 9

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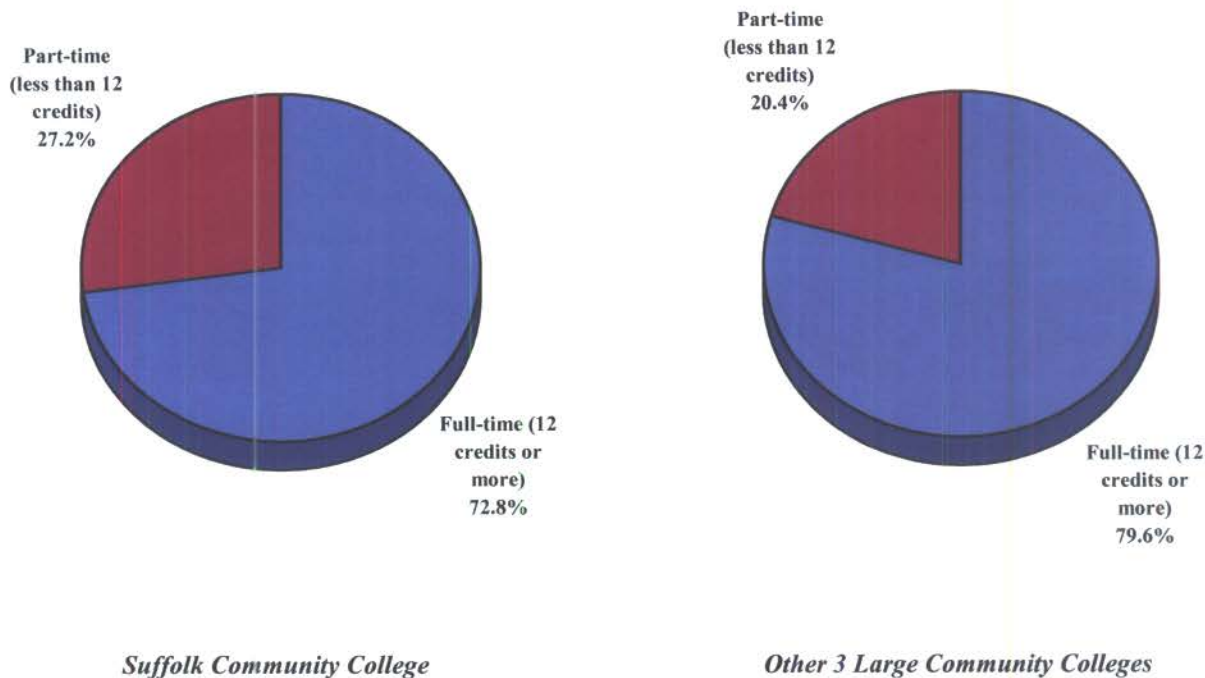
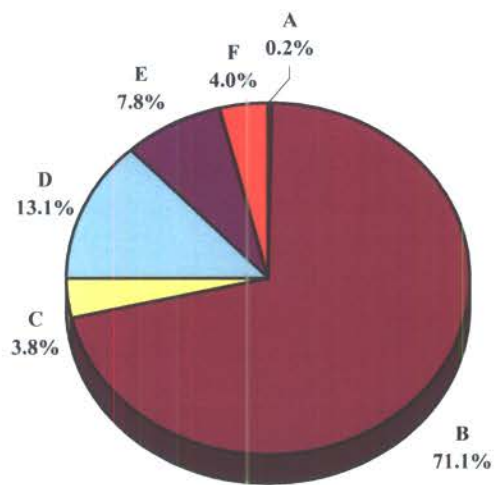


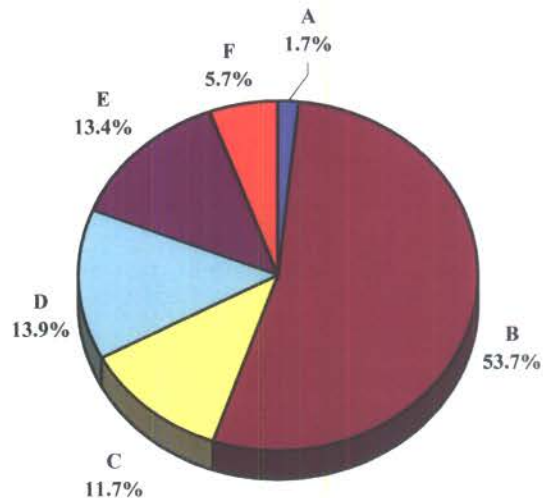
Figure 27. Section IV, Item 12

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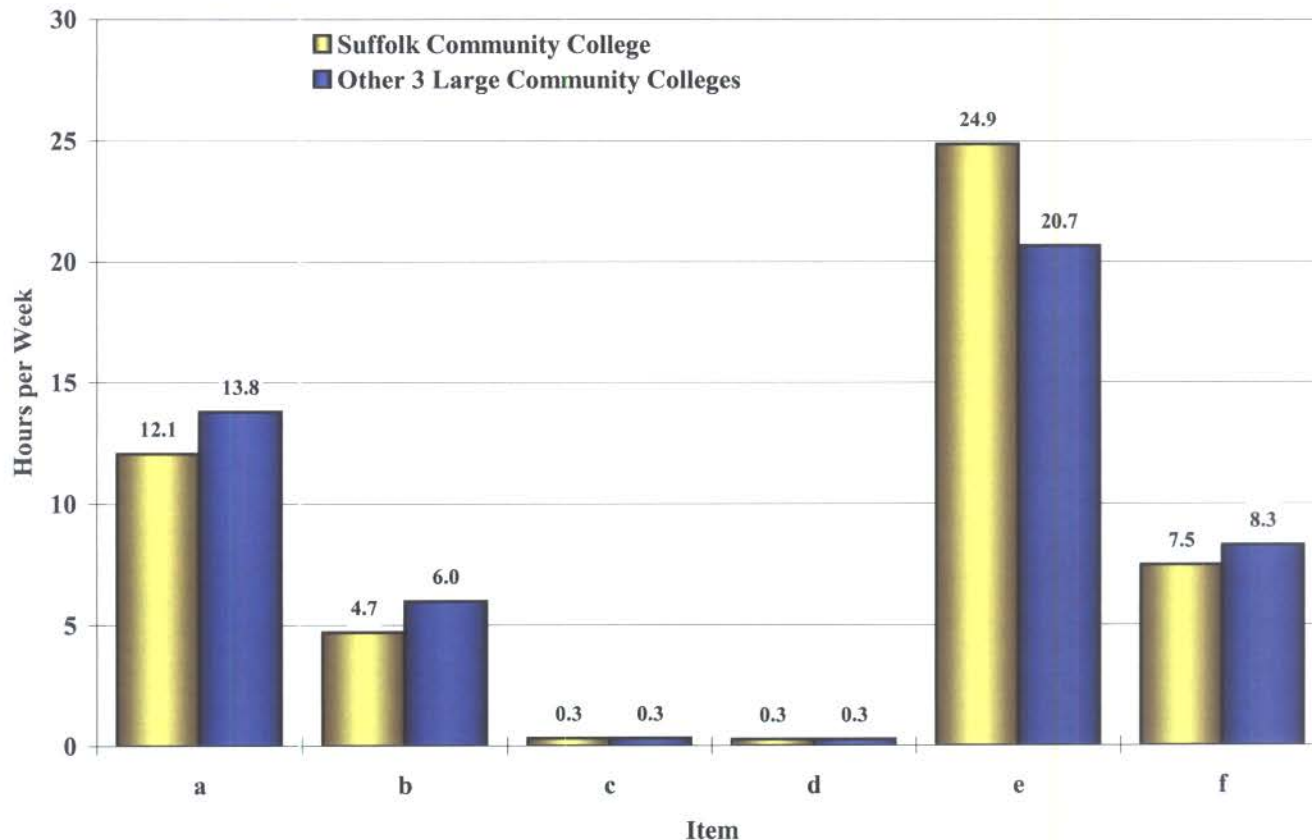
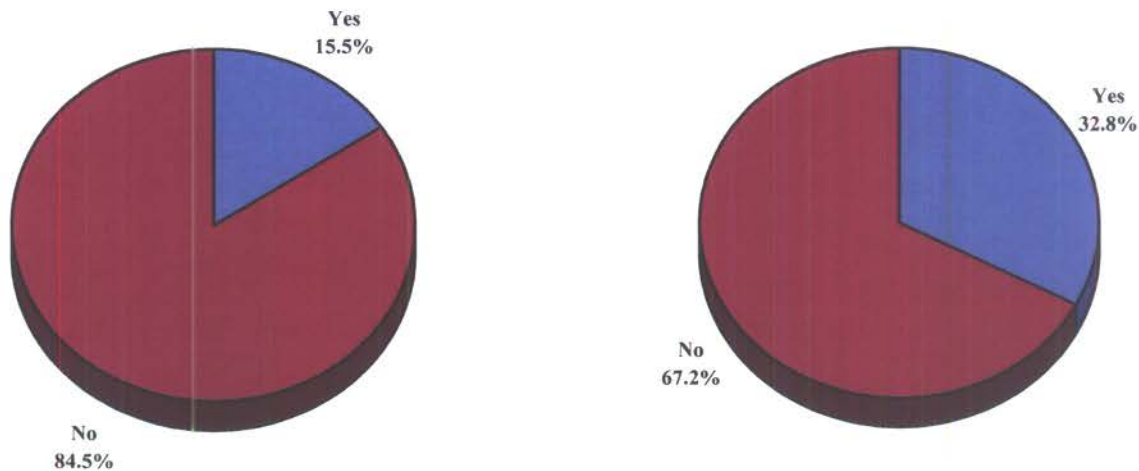


Figure 29. Section V, Item 14: Median Hours Spent per Week On Each Activity
