Acceptance to the College

You will receive a **Letter of Acceptance** after the Office of Admissions receives your **completed** admissions application and your **official** high school transcript.

Health History Form and Immunization

Records should be submitted prior to placement testing and registering for classes at your home campus's Health Services Office, (*Immunization records can be requested from your high school or prior college.*)

6

Placement Testing and Advising:

Testing may be required to determine the level of classes you should be taking when you enroll. The Office of Testing and Advising will contact you if a placement test is needed and/or to schedule your academic advising appointment.

7

Register for Classes:

After being advised by a counselor, you will be provided with assistance in choosing your classes as well as registration instructions.

8

Pay Your Bill:

Tuition must be paid by the due date on your bill. Students can choose a payment plan or pay in full. If financial aid covers your tuition, you **MUST CONFIRM** your attendance online through the "My SCCC" student portal or with the cashier.

9

Photo ID Cards / Parking Permits

Both should be obtained before classes begin. An **SCCC Photo ID Card** is mandatory and must be carried at all times while on campus. **Vehicle registration/parking permits** are obtained online through the student portal (My SCCC) after you have made a payment on your bill.

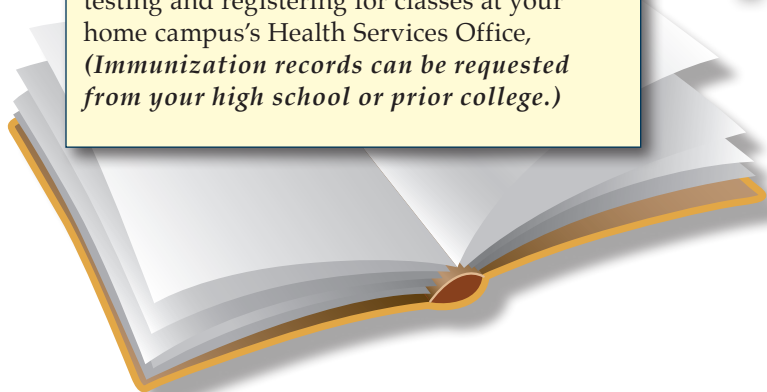
New Student Orientation Day:
