SUBJECT: New Department of Health Guidance Expands Eligibility for Faculty and Staff to Qualify to Receive COVID-19 Vaccine

New York State Department of Health

Program guidance that will result in making all in-person, essential staff at the College (faculty and staff) a priority group that is immediately eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at any State or Local Health Department-operated vaccine site. The new guidance now includes a priority designation for "In-Person College Faculty and Essential In-Person Staff," as well as a new category for "Public-facing Government and Public Employees" that will become effective March 17. Appendix A (pages 8-10) of the guidance document, contains the full list of the New York State Priority Groups Eligible to be Vaccinated as vaccine supplies become available. The revised guidance covers all staff who are currently working in-person at the College, regardless of job title or job function. The Am I Eligible app is the quickest way to make an appointment at a state-operated vaccination site. Clicking this link will bring you to a Get Started button.

If you do choose to submit this information to HR, this does not preclude you from making an appointment for the vaccine at another location. Furthermore, if you already have an appointment to be vaccinated, you should not cancel that appointment as there is no estimate on the time when you may receive an appointment with Suffolk County. Also, please keep in mind that an appointment is not a guarantee that vaccine will be available on the day of your appointment. Keep all your options open until you are actually vaccinated!
