SUBJECT: Walk-in COVID-19 Vaccinations Available at all Campuses for College Employees and Students

Michael J. Grant Campus (State-Operated Mass Vaccination Site)

Last week, Governor Andrew M. Cuomo announced that all New York State mass vaccination sites—including the Suffolk Federal Credit Union Arena located on the College's Michael J. Grant Campus in Brentwood— will now accommodate walk-in appointments for eligible New Yorkers 16 years of age and older who are seeking to be vaccinated.

Any College employee or student who is interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccine, is advised that walk-in appointments can now be scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Brentwood location.

Please note that walk-in appointments are reserved for first doses only, with second doses being scheduled automatically after administration of the initial shot.

Ammerman and Eastern Campuses (County Points of Distribution)

In addition, Suffolk County has just indicated that its Points of Distribution (POD) located in the William J. Lindsay Life Sciences Building on the Ammerman Campus in Selden and the Eastern Campus Health and Wellness Center in Riverhead will also begin accommodating walk-in appointments for eligible New Yorkers 16 years of age and older who are seeking to be vaccinated.

Any College employee or student who is interested in receiving the COVID-19 vaccine, is advised that walk-in appointments can now be completed at both of these locations. Please note that Suffolk County walk-ins are only available on varied days and times. Please refer to the attached SCDHS flyer for more information on this first set of dates and times.

Please note that walk-in appointments are reserved for first doses only, with second doses being scheduled automatically after administration of the initial shot.

While vaccination is not mandatory at this time, it is strongly encouraged.
