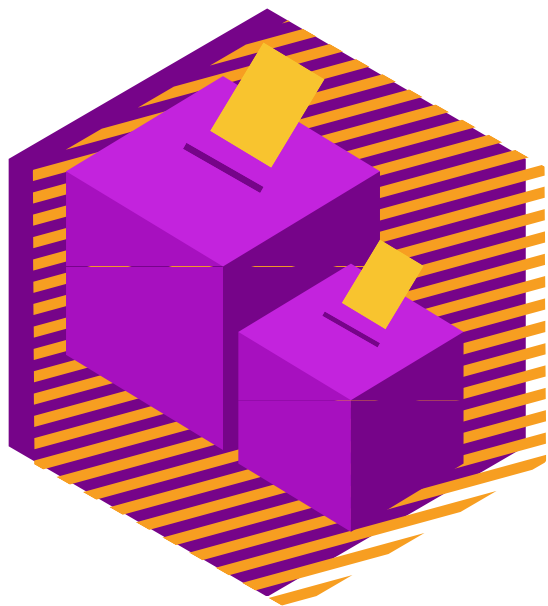

Building Civic Engagement and Voter Registration Across the College

Ask Every Student is a national joint initiative that facilitates collaboration between campus leaders and nonprofit partners to help campuses “ask every student” to participate in the democratic process and achieve full student voter registration. SUNY Suffolk has received \$6,000 in funding to facilitate this initiative while supporting our own commitment to civic engagement.



Eight students across SUNY Suffolk's three campuses have been selected to serve as *Ask Every Student* Ambassadors and will receive stipends for their role in informing fellow students about voter registration and engagement.



In preparation for the position, these ambassadors underwent training for bipartisan engagement and proper voter registration from the League of Women Voters Suffolk County, a nonpartisan organization offering voter assistance and outreach for voter education.



Ambassadors will host information tables in high traffic areas and be present during Common Hour and events on campus to encourage students to register to vote, find their districts, and offer suggestions for Election Day plans (i.e. polling location verification). Presentations for clubs and organizations are also available.
