## Getting Started with Technology at SUNY Suffolk



### Create Your Username and Password

If you are a new student at SUNY Suffolk, you will need to create a username and password to access the college's systems as well as to log into campus computers. To do so, log in on the college home page ([sunysuffolk.edu](http://sunysuffolk.edu)) or go directly to [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login) and click on New Student Account Creation.




### Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) and Password Reset

Suffolk has implemented a more robust and unified identity management service. The MFA provides an extra layer of protection when accessing Suffolk systems such as Office 365 and Degree Works. Set up your MFA at [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login).

**Once your MFA is set up, if you forget your password you can change it at any time by clicking on the Forgot Password link.**

### SUNY Suffolk Login Portal

Once you have a Suffolk username and password and have set up your MFA, you will be able to access the SUNY Suffolk Login Portal at [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login). From there you will have access to the systems you need such as Brightspace, MySCCC, Office 365, Email, OneDrive and more. Once you are in the Suffolk Login Portal, you can also reset/change your password and manage your security factors (authentication methods) by clicking on your name in the upper right corner and selecting Profile. To go back to the initial Suffolk Login Portal, click on the Suffolk logo on the top left.



### SUNY Suffolk Email

Your Suffolk email is the official form of communication from the college. Once you create your Suffolk account, you will need to activate your Suffolk email. To do so, log in to the SUNY Suffolk Login Portal at [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login), select Outlook Mail and enter your full Suffolk email address (username@mail.sunysuffolk.edu). Follow the prompts to set up your email.



### Microsoft Office

As a student at Suffolk you have access to Microsoft Office 365, including Word, Excel, Power Point, OneDrive, Teams and more. Did you know that your Suffolk email address is also a Microsoft Office 365 account? Log in to the SUNY Suffolk Login Portal at [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login) go to Office 365 to access all that Microsoft Office 365 has to offer. **You may Download Office 365 Apps for free on up to five devices.**



### Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi connectivity is available to all Suffolk students and employees. To connect, go to your device settings and select the public network SCCC-Public.



### Digital Learning at Suffolk

Brightspace is the current Digital Learning Environment (DLE) at Suffolk. To access Brightspace, log in to the SUNY Suffolk Login Portal at [sunysuffolk.edu/login](http://sunysuffolk.edu/login), go to Brightspace, click on Network Login and select Suffolk from the campus list. Once in Brightspace, you will have online access to your registered courses and related information. ### Zoom

### MS Teams

All faculty and students at the college have a Microsoft Office 365 subscription, which allows everyone to utilize the Microsoft Teams app. To access Teams, sign into Office 365 and select the Teams app from the App Launcher (waffle) on the upper left corner. Using your full Suffolk email address to sign in, you will have access to the teams you are part of and will be able to participate in them.
